

Access Status

Niagara:

Niagara Glen – Open to bouldering. Please see the interim guidelines available on [OAC website](#).

Camden Crag – Unknown – Volunteers Needed.

Milton:

Mt. Nemo South – Climbs south of Bookends are on private property.

Mt. Nemo - TR ban, no slinging of trees. Caution advised with some bolts.

Rattlesnake Pt – no slinging of cedars, avoid slinging of trees (use the bolts where installed).

Buffalo Crag – no slinging of cedars, avoid slinging of trees.

Kelso - Corner Route to Armorall are open to climbing. No slinging of cedars.

Cow Crag - Private property.

Crag X - Private property.

Punk Rock - Private property.

Rockwood – CLOSED. Proposal is being brought before Conservation Area Board.

Beaver Valley:

Metcalf – no camping.

Old Baldy - Permit Required from [Grey Sauble Conservation area](#). Climbing Guidelines in effect.

Eugenia - CLOSED. Environmental Assessment of climbing specific routes is being conducted.

Devil's Glen - Access point is via park. Access from the west across private property may lead to an encounter with an angry land-owner. Access from the north is across private property, and requires owner's permission.

Berlin Wall – Unknown - extreme caution advised with old bolts.

Cliff Barnes - Private Property.

Bowles Bluff - Private Property.

Bruce Peninsula:

Skinner's Bluff – Unknown – Volunteers needed.

Malcolm Bluff/Disneyland – Unknown – Volunteers needed.

Cape Croker -Fee required. Crag is on private property.

TV Tower –Private Property. Climbing is tolerated, however, act as good stewards and keep a low profile! No camping anywhere in forest or along approach road. Volunteers needed.

Lion's Head – Highly sensitive area. Strive for minimal impact and low profile.

White's Bluff – No parking on cottage road. Instead park in the Bruce Trail lot, located further west along road #9. Approach the beach along the west side of the fencing, and stay away from the cottages.

Halfway Dump - CLOSED. Memorandum of Understanding being presented to National Parks. Roped climbing is currently allowed.

Eastern Ontario:

Eagle's Nest (Bancroft) – Cliff behind the Laundromat area is on private property. Fingerstinger, Stairway to Heaven are within accessible portion of cliff.

Bon Echo – Permit required (available at the gatehouse or via ACC –Toronto).

Kingston Mills – Unknown – Volunteers needed.

Dog Lake – Private Property.

Little Blue Mountain – Private Property.

The OAC reminds you to back-up fixed protection when appropriate and to act as good stewards.
